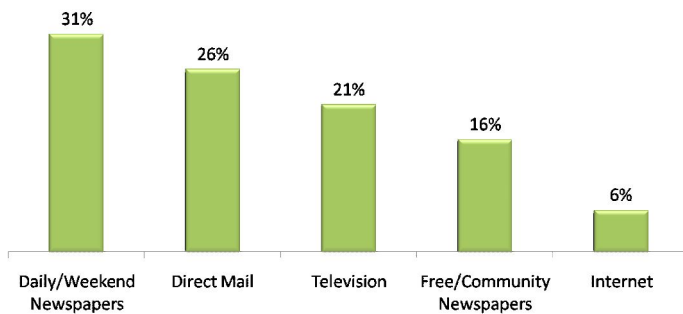

People that have visited a men's fashion store in the last month choose daily/weekend newspapers for information on Clothing/footwear more than any other media source.

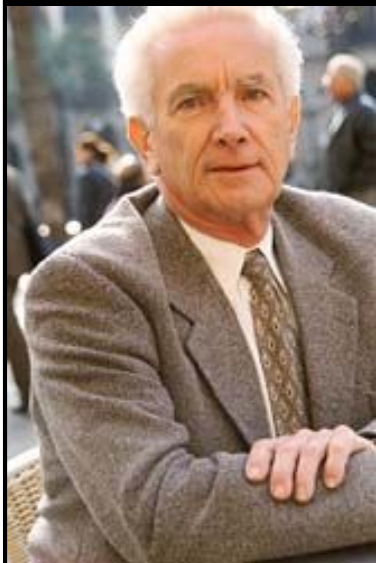
Out of the top five media sources for information on menswear, almost a third of people 15+ look to daily/weekend newspapers.
