A1 Team.NZL hits the streets of Durban this weekend, for Round 7 of the A1GP World Cup of Motorsport. The 3.2km Durban circuit was specifically designed for A1GP and is the only street circuit on the A1GP calendar. Its tight, twisting layout leaves little room for error, making it one of the most difficult circuits of the season. New Zealand's Jonny Reid has never raced in Durban so will have to be at the top of his game if A1 Team.NZL are to build a championship lead. With just four rounds remaining, the Kiwis are tied with France at the top of the points table, but lead the 22-nation series by virtue of more race wins.
